The Built Ford Tough AQHYA World Championship Show is the pinnacle event for American Quarter Horse exhibitors ages 18 and under around the world competing in classes representing halter, English and western disciplines. More than 5,075 entries from the United States and Canada are competing for 42 world championships, 33 Adequan® Level 2 and 39 Nutrena Level 1 championship titles at this year's event, July 29 - August 8 at OKC Fairgrounds in Oklahoma City.
