

# EASY JET NO-BAKE COOKIES

With a big heart and blistering speed, Easy Jet earned a spot among the legendary figures of the Quarter Horse world.

The sorrel stallion was born in 1967 and was a product of [Walter Merrick's](#) breeding program. Easy Jet was sired by the phenomenal [Jet Deck](#) and out of the Thoroughbred mare [Lena's Bar \(TB\)](#) by [Three Bars \(TB\)](#).

He had an illustrious racing career and was inducted into the American Quarter Horse Hall of Fame in 1993.

So, if you are ready for your own horse race, just like Easy Jet, follow this easy recipe for his No-Bake Cookies.

## Ingredients:

- ½ cup peanut butter or sunflower butter for peanut allergies
- ¾ cup powdered sugar
- ¼ cup of milk
- 1 cup Quaker Oats (quick or old fashioned, uncooked)
- ¾ cup unsweetened puffed wheat or granola
- ¼ cup apple chips crunched into small pieces

## Steps:

1. Measure out ingredients into a large bowl. Combine peanut butter, sugar, and milk; mix well.
2. Stir in oats and remaining ingredients.
3. Drop rounded teaspoonfuls of the mixture onto waxed paper.
4. Let stand until firm, then enjoy! Make sure to store leftovers in a tightly covered container.
