The Built Ford Tough AQHYA World Championship Show is the pinnacle event for American Quarter Horse exhibitors ages 18 and under around the world, competing in each of the classes representing halter, English and western disciplines. More than 5,860 entries from the United States, Canada, Paraguay and South Africa are competing for 42 world championships, 33 Adequan® Level 2 championships and 39 Nutrena Level 1 championships at this year's event, July 28 - August 8 at the OKC Fairgrounds in Oklahoma City.
